MEAL MINISTRY UPDATE AND ADDRESSING RUMORS

In mid August, New Life Ministries shared an important update regarding the New Life Community Meal Ministry. As of August 12, 2024, individuals began to receive only one (1) free meal per serving time at the New Life Community Meal Ministry.

At the start of 2024, New Life Ministries had announced that we were expanding our services by beginning to offer carryout meals. When making this decision, we were also faced with the decision of how many meals to offer. At the time, the decision was made to allow individuals the option to take up to two free meals during each serving period. This decision was made with hope that we would be able to serve a larger population in our community. Some individuals would take two, but many continued to only take one.

As the year went on, like many, we were impacted by the rising costs of food and utilities. We began to see our donations decrease as others were navigating these increases too. Our supplies were decreasing while the needs in our community were rapidly increasing. By the end of July, we had already served 4,911 lunches and 12,908 dinners. This is a significant increase from our numbers at this time in 2023, having only served 2,282 lunches and 7,481 dinners.

When we were offering two free meals per serving time, we knew were were helping but we also knew that we were providing extra. After multiple conversations between the Executive Director and Meal Ministry Director, the difficult decision was made to move back to one meal per person per serving time.

With this change came many misconceptions. The New Life Community Meal Ministry is still serving free meals to all people. An individual is welcome to come down and enjoy a meal every time our doors are open, we will just be serving one meal rather than two per person.

This change was not made due to not being able to afford to run this ministry. Rather, New Life Ministries wants to continue to be good stewards of what the Lord has blessed us with and are thankful for every person who has donated funds or supplies to help us prepare and serve our community. This ministry is a community ministry and we are thankful for all the support we receive.
